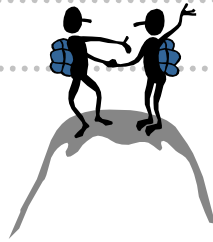

Scheduling Summit

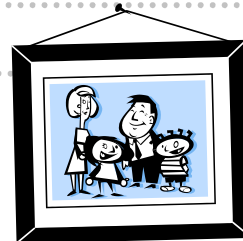


On January 8 many of the leaders of the church convened to create a harmonious calendar of events for the New Year. Look for a bulletin insert containing the results. On page 2 of

this newsletter you will see the results of last year's Scheduling Summit. You will be happy to know that many of last year's activities will be back by popular demand for this year.

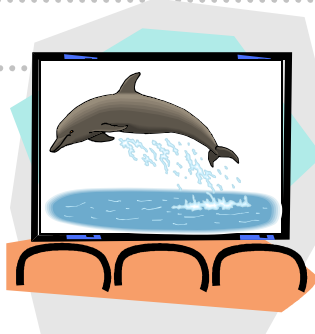
Family Ministries
